

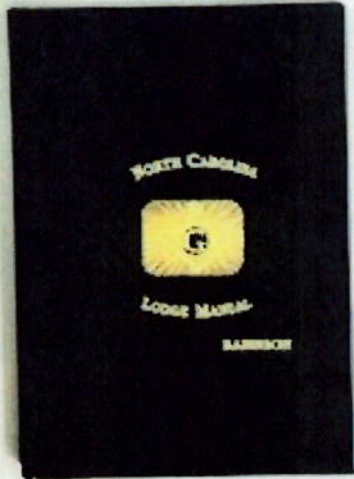
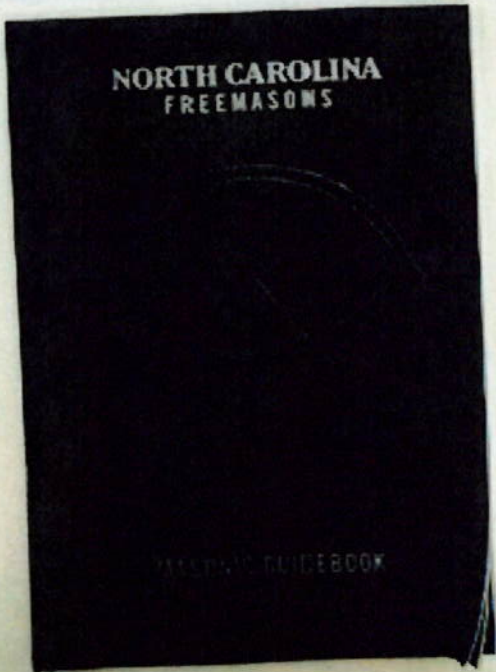
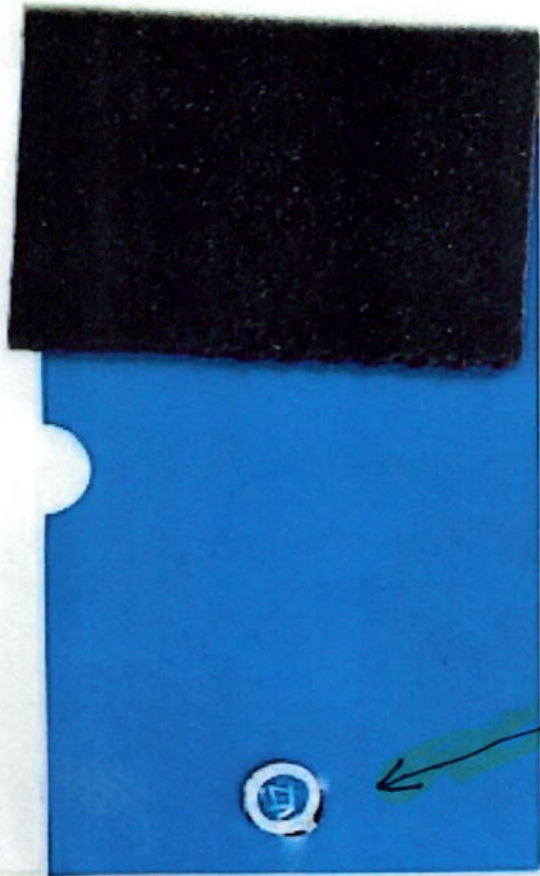
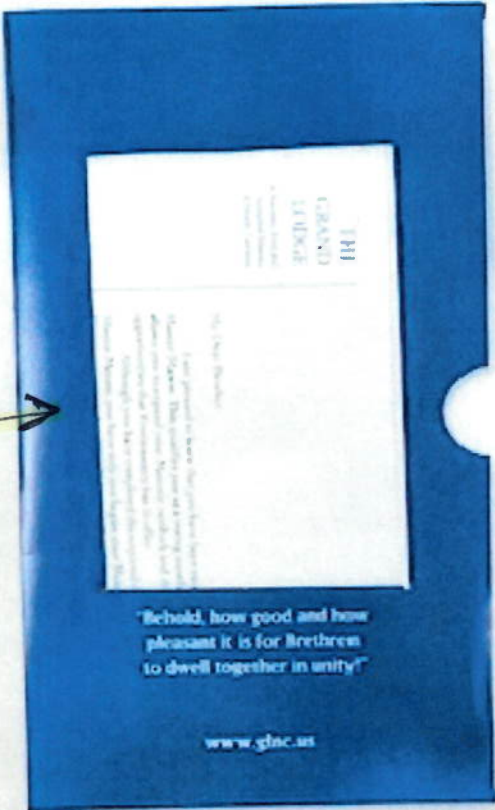
The packet contains the following components:
