It seems that every year, every Lodge has that dreaded discussion: 'How many Brothers have yet to pay their dues?' This is written concerning that topic.

First, let's explore what our Lodge uses our dues for throughout the year:

Bills (electric, propane, water, insurance, per capita)

Charity (Masons give charitably. The Lessons of our Degrees not only suggest it but direct it to be done.)

Events (whether it be our Widow and Awards Night or our Open House, etc.)

And improvements to our Lodge and Masonry.

Second, let's look at when annual dues are to be made:

Our By-Laws state that it is to be paid in ADVANCE on or before the first day of January. This means that if your dues are not paid on or before January 1st, you are officially in arears.

Lastly, let's look at the consequences when the Brothers of a Lodge do not pay until the last minute:

Our Lodge cannot pay its required obligations. We pay our regular bills but also support others. Some of these are needed to be paid during the year. (Founding Forward, Relay for Life, etc).

Brethren, it is understood that your cabletow is only so long financially, and sometimes we need a little extra time to take care of our Lodge obligations. If you have any concerns, please let me know.
